Very Good News

Our building work for the new classroom (above 4H, eventually replacing the mobile classroom) will start on June 27th.

A temporary access route will be laid from the Buryfield entrance, across the top of our playing field, for contractors' vehicles. This will ensure that all building works are secured and kept separate from the children for the last few weeks of term.

The classroom should be ready for September – which is good news!

Even Better News!

Bucks County Council have agreed to **FUND OUR DROP OFF ZONE!!**

We found out this week that they will progress the construction of the coach turning circle and drop off zone in conjunction with the construction of our two new classrooms, new ICT suite, hand washing facilities and the new KS2 entrance.

Work is planned to start in November 2016. The current ICT block will be demolished and the new accommodation will "infill" this area. This is an investment of over £1 million in our buildings and £250,000 for the drop off zone.

We have consistently communicated to Bucks CC that we can only accommodate the regular 3 form intake into Year 3 if adequate parking and drop off facilities are provided – and they have agreed!

This is fantastic news, and will lead to a reduction of parental stress throughout Great Missenden.

Please bear with us in the short term – building work will last for most of the next academic year.

But it will be worth it!
