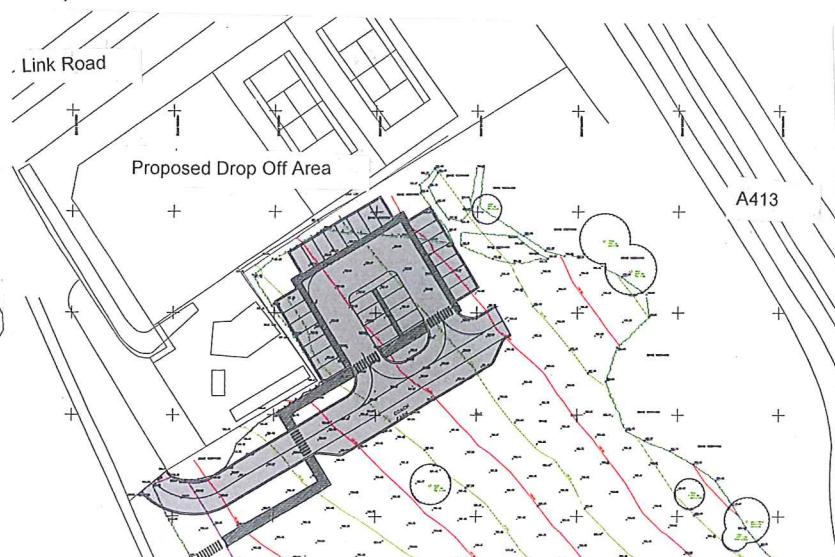
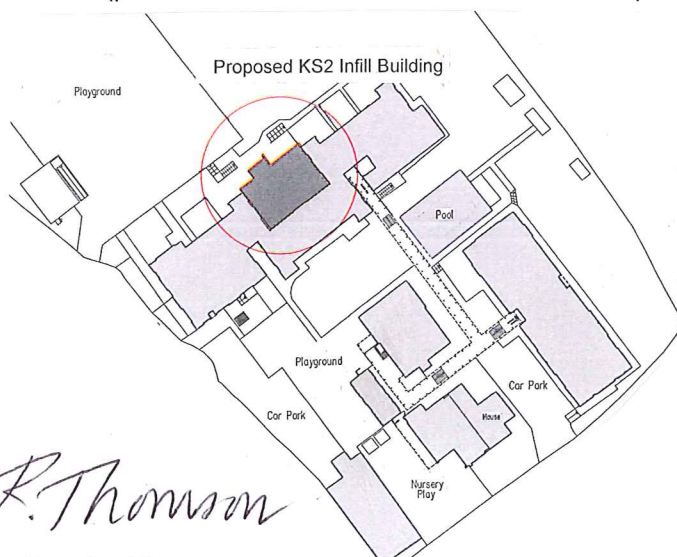

The plans have been drawn up by Contour Architects and the project is funded by Bucks County Council.

Our aim is to preserve the beauty and green space of our village surroundings, so the new build occupies the same footprint as the existing school. The drop-off area will be landscaped to retain, as far as possible, existing trees and playing field space.

The drop-off area will greatly improve traffic congestion in the village, encouraging parents to access the school from the A413 / Link Road rather than driving down the High Street and Church Street.
